### Present

<b>I</b>	benefit
<b>you</b>	benefit
<b>he/she/it</b>	benefits
<b>we</b>	benefit
<b>you</b>	benefit
<b>they</b>	benefit

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	benefited
<b>you</b>	benefited
<b>he/she/it</b>	benefited
<b>we</b>	benefited
<b>you</b>	benefited
<b>they</b>	benefited

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have benefited
<b>you</b>	have benefited
<b>he/she/it</b>	has benefited
<b>we</b>	have benefited
<b>you</b>	have benefited
<b>they</b>	have benefited

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had benefited
<b>you</b>	had benefited
<b>he/she/it</b>	had benefited
<b>we</b>	had benefited
<b>you</b>	had benefited
<b>they</b>	had benefited

### Future

<b>I</b>	will benefit
<b>you</b>	will benefit
<b>he/she/it</b>	will benefit
<b>we</b>	will benefit

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have benefited
<b>you</b>	will have benefited
<b>he/she/it</b>	will have benefited

## Conditional

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am benefiting
<b>you</b>	are benefiting
<b>he/she/it</b>	is benefiting
<b>we</b>	are benefiting
<b>you</b>	are benefiting
<b>they</b>	are benefiting

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was benefiting
<b>you</b>	were benefiting
<b>he/she/it</b>	was benefiting
<b>we</b>	were benefiting
<b>you</b>	were benefiting
<b>they</b>	were benefiting

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been benefiting
<b>you</b>	have been benefiting
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been benefiting
<b>we</b>	have been benefiting
<b>you</b>	have been benefiting
<b>they</b>	have been benefiting

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been benefiting
<b>you</b>	had been benefiting
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been benefiting
<b>we</b>	had been benefiting
<b>you</b>	had been benefiting
<b>they</b>	had been benefiting

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be benefiting
<b>you</b>	will be benefiting
