### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have injured
<b>you</b>	have injured
<b>he/she/it</b>	has injured
<b>we</b>	have injured
<b>you</b>	have injured
<b>they</b>	have injured

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had injured

<b>he/she/it</b>	had injured

<b>you</b>	are injuring
<b>he/she/it</b>	is injuring

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was injuring
<b>you</b>	were injuring
<b>he/she/it</b>	was injuring
<b>we</b>	were injuring
<b>you</b>	were injuring
<b>they</b>	were injuring

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been injuring
<b>you</b>	have been injuring
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been injuring
<b>we</b>	have been injuring
<b>you</b>	have been injuring
<b>they</b>	have been injuring

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been injuring
<b>you</b>	had been injuring
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been injuring
