<b>he/she/it</b>	was spending
<b>we</b>	were spending
<b>you</b>	were spending
<b>they</b>	were spending

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been spending
<b>you</b>	have been spending
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been spending
<b>we</b>	have been spending
<b>you</b>	have been spending
<b>they</b>	have been spending

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been spending
<b>you</b>	had been spending
