### Present

<b>I</b>	utter
<b>you</b>	utter
<b>he/she/it</b>	utters
<b>we</b>	utter
<b>you</b>	utter
<b>they</b>	utter

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am uttering
<b>you</b>	are uttering
<b>he/she/it</b>	is uttering
<b>we</b>	are uttering
<b>you</b>	are uttering
<b>they</b>	are uttering

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	uttered
<b>you</b>	uttered
<b>he/she/it</b>	uttered
<b>we</b>	uttered
<b>you</b>	uttered
<b>they</b>	uttered

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was uttering
<b>you</b>	were uttering
<b>he/she/it</b>	was uttering
<b>we</b>	were uttering

### Present perfect

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been uttering
<b>you</b>	have been uttering
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been uttering
<b>we</b>	have been uttering
<b>you</b>	have been uttering

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had uttered
<b>you</b>	had uttered
